MCTV Acquires Centre TV Cable and Powhatan Point Cable

With this acquisition, MCTV has expanded its service area further into southeastern Ohio and West Virginia.

MCTV currently offers residential and business services to more than 52,000 homes and businesses across its service areas.

Centre TV Cable and Powhatan Point Cable were founded by Kasmir (Kaz) Majewski in 1965 and 1966, respectively. Centre TV Cable serves neighborhoods and communities in northern Wheeling, WV while Powhatan Point Cable serves customers in the Powhatan Point and Colerain township areas of Belmont County.

“In the 1950s and 60s, men and women like Kaz were building cable systems in small towns across America. While the technology seems simple by today’s standards, this was a huge undertaking,” Gessner stated. “The robust telecommunications infrastructure many small American towns have today is thanks to the dedication and ingenuity of people like Kaz. We are honored to continue - and build upon - his legacy.”

Founded in 1965 in Massillon, Ohio, MCTV primarily serves communities in Stark and Wayne counties. Since 2018, MCTV has acquired systems serving five communities across Ohio, including the recent acquisition of Bellaire Cable TV. These recent acquisitions align with and demonstrate MCTV’s mission of strengthening communities by providing improved Internet and cable TV services for the areas we serve.
